Co-production in Norfolk



This summer we celebrated National Co-production Week (3–7 July 2017) by making a short film about co-production in Norfolk

– and co-producing it, of course. In the film, Family Voice Norfolk with the Local Authority and Health colleagues are seen working together to improve services for children and young people with SEND, while the voices of young people themselves focus on the issues that most concern them.

Jacob Furniss, who directed, filmed and edited the film, is himself a young man with special educational needs. With an officer from the Local Offer as his sound man, he filmed a wide variety of events demonstrating Norfolk's commitment to coproduction.
