HEAD LICE

We have had some reports that head lice have returned! The only way they can be controlled is if every parent checks their child's hair and if head lice are present, treats the child. Head lice are well camouflaged and hide when disturbed by combing. They do not always cause itching particularly when recently arrived on the head. They may also be few in number and a

quick inspection is unlikely to detect them.

Use conditioner and a fine toothed comb, checking the comb for lice after each stroke as you work through the hair section by section, so that the whole head is combed through. Rinse out the conditioner and repeat the combing procedure in the wet hair.

If you find lice, treat using lotions obtainable from a pharmacist or by using the wet combing method.
