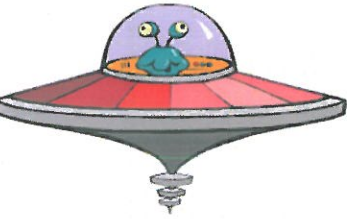


## GOLDEN BOOK AWARD

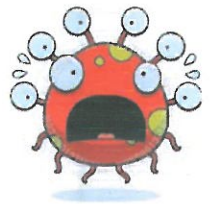


## Alien Invasion Day!

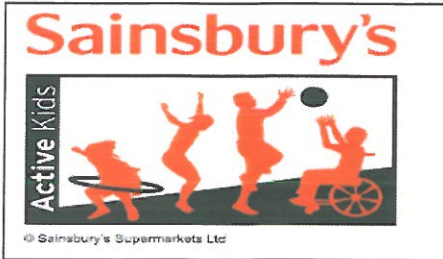

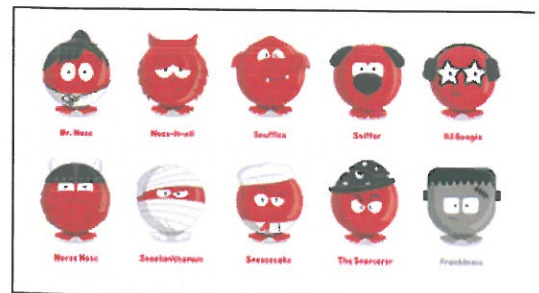
