Dear Parents/Carers

COVID-19 Update – CRITICAL WORKER PLACES JUNE 2020

Thank you for responding to the parent survey that has enabled us to better understand what the demand might be for your children to return to school for each of our schools.

As a result of the responses received, it is clear that we are likely to have an increased demand for Critical Worker's children in all year groups from Reception to Year 6 as a result of the plan for the wider re-opening of our schools.

The places for Critical Workers' children are to be prioritised above all other pupils.

Therefore, in order to complete our plans, we must now ask all Critical Workers (previously known as Key Workers) who require a place for their child to apply for a place. You must apply for a place no matter what year group your child is in.

If your child already has a place due to your Critical Worker status – you do not need to re-apply. You will know if your child already has a place as they will have attended one of our school sites since the school was closed to all other pupils, i.e. **they will have attended during the period since 23 March 2020.**

If you would like to apply for a Critical Worker place for your child, please return the application form with the additional information required by Friday 29 May 2020 at the latest. Please return the form and information by email to the office email address of the school where your child is registered.

Thank you once again for your assistance with this. We will communicate and confirm places with you further once all applications have been received. We will then also let you know what date the place will start and additional details such as the start and finish times for your child's 'bubble'.
